The two turns were first gear operations with rapid entries and exits for good acceleration.

The competitive spirit ran strong as everyone was taking advantage of the opportunity to legally stand on the gas. No backing, no parking, no strings to turn on, no balls to pick up; just put your foot in it and go—a real pleasure. This leads to the unpleasant task of trying to describe observing \$9,000 worth of Porsches go over in a matter of several minutes. Two 356 B Porsche coupes, Fred Johnson and Alan Fine, trying to gain the best possible times rolled on the same corner at the same spot on two successive runs. As a vivid testimonial for seat belts, neither driver was injured. This is one of the more exciting VMSC events and we are all looking for—ward to the Fourth Annual Field Trials next year.

The Skyline Drive will be incorporated into the route instructions for Sunday, and the pleasure of this trip alone will be worth the nominal entry fee of \$18.50 per team, which shall consist of two persons only. The final checkpoint will be west of Richmond on route #250, enabling entrants to return to the tri-city area before dark on Sunday.


