• New arrival but already a couple of months old. Jim and Karen Spivey are sporting a new little "Spy".

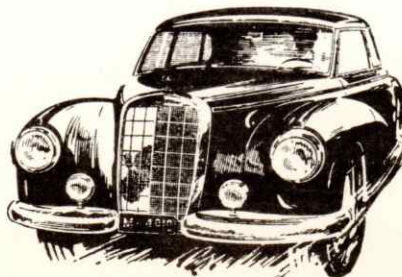

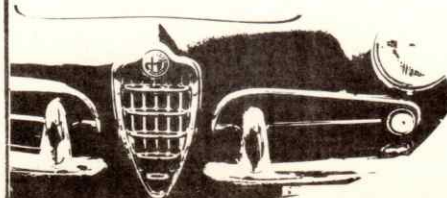

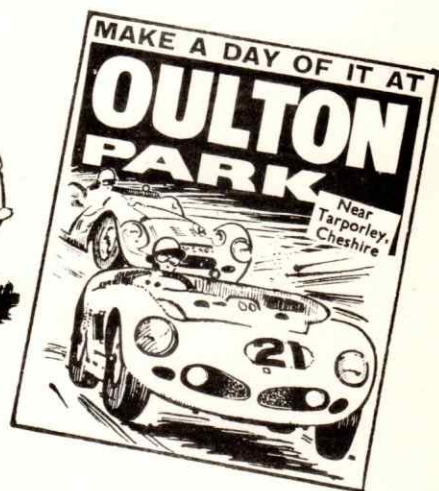
