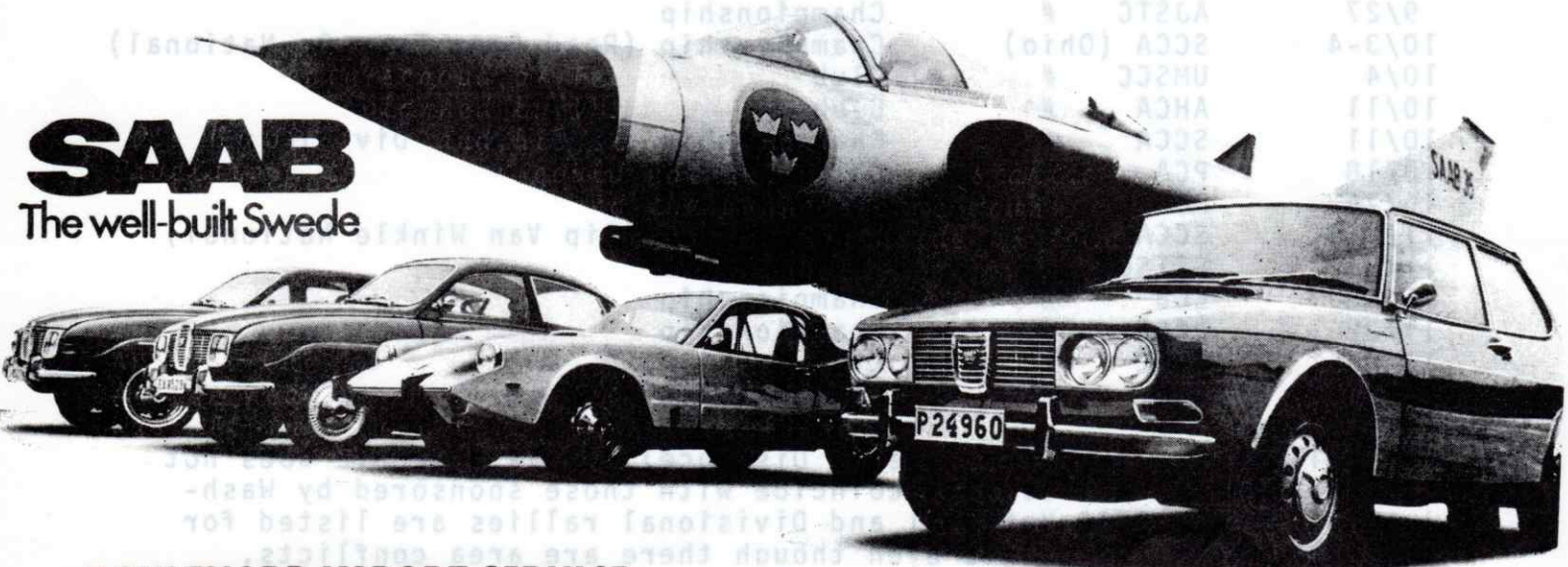
G W's B Rally
