



EDITORIAL

Cruising down the open highway on a beautiful sunny day, with the wind in your hair, and visions of Ferraris in your head, your pleasures are suddenly cut short by that all too familar screaming of a siren. Seems that you overstepped the speed limit by 5 or 6 miles per hour, and received a summons for same. On another day, cold, foggy, and raining, you brashly whipped down the turnpike at 65, wipers unable to keep the glass clear, and vision reduced by rain and fog. But you were not breaking the law, except maybe the law of common sense.

Now this means you can kill yourself legally, and be arrested for a violation of a speed law, even when you were not putting your self or anyone else in danger by doing so. Doesn*t seem fair does it? But if we abolish the open road speed laws, half of the population will tailgate the other half into the morgue, or so we are told by the National Safety Council and friends. But do they really know this, are is this just a politically motivated statement, necessary to keep those local coffers lined with traffic ticket moneys?

I. PURPOSE

To implement a system for the accumulation of points counting towards more desirable trophies. This system is intended to complement our present system of awarding trophies based on monies available. The use of pewter trophies as described below will be limited to awards given under this point accumulation system.

II. DEFINITION OF TROPHIES

Trophies to be used in this system will be the following:

- A. Pewter Beer Mug w/glass bottom.
- B. Fewter Pilsner Stein.
- C. Fewter Jefferson Cup.

All will be engraved with the VMSC logo. No other engraving will be done.

III. POINTS

Points will be awarded to each club entrant in the following manner:

* Rally or Autocross

1st overall in a rally or F.T.D. in an autocross will be awarded 1 bonus point.

IV. VALUE

Awards will be valued in the following manner:

Beer Mug or Pilsner Stein...... 8 points accumulation

Jefferson Cup...... 4 points accumulation

V. POINT ACCUMULATION

After the scoring of each event is completed, the C.D. shall contact each trophy winner and determine if that individual desires that points be accumulated or standard trophies purchased. After all winners have been contacted this information shall be forwarded to the trophy chairman. Point redemption tickets will be awarded at club meetings in lieu of trophies for those persons desiring point accumulation. Individuals will be required to turn in point accumulation tickets to the trophy chairman for redemption. Any excess points, not used for redemption, will be accumulated toward next trophy. Each individual will be responsible for maintaining possession of point accumulation tickets. No duplicates will be issued. Team points may be combined to obtain trophies. This system applies to VMSC members only.


