


If the protests aren't enough, the constant bitching by the protestors and their followers screws up everybody elses evening.



Another Mazda owner in the Club - Bruce James. Too bad, Bruce, you thought you were first: beat by Women's Lib again!



The rally left Richmond, and travelled through New Kent to West Point where we had our morning break, then we travelled to Toano and back to West Point where the lunch stop was. After a very short lunch (I emphasize short because that is one thing Bookie didn't do was to give a long enough stop), we left on a beautiful ride through King and Queen County to Aylett for the afternoon break. The last leg was a leisurely ride to Dino's. Dino's had opened just for us and the meal was excellent. I recommend eating there because the food is excellent and we may be able to use it again.

Even though the rally was perfectly planned and laid out, there were three areas of the rally that I believe need talking about. The first was a small tannish-yellow, eight by eleven paper sign that was nailed on a brown tree. For proof of this, twenty nine of thirty five contestants either maxed or missed the next control, but the leg was very clean.

The second area was that our phones at one of the controls started acting up, so that the control was not giving out the proper times, etc. So the control was administratively thrown out.

The third area is a very sore area with me. On the last control before the afternoon break, Bookie had an instruction that an out of town rallyist protested because there was a small punctuation error which did not change the meaning at all. The protest committee used laborious logic to throw this control out. But overall, the Eight Hour Rally was well organized, enjoyable to run, and ran through beautiful countryside.




