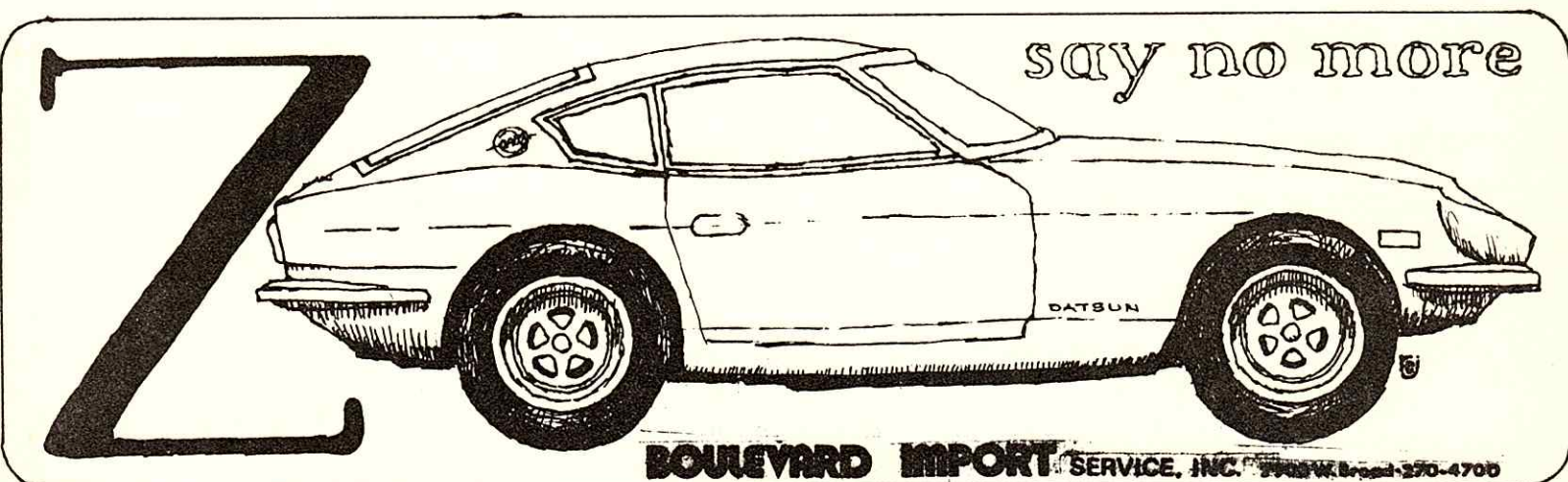
A First Course in Navigating

BY-LAW NOTES

At the last regular Club meeting, the membership approved a previously presented change in the By-Laws concerning dues for Life Members:

Add to Article III, Paragraph IV:

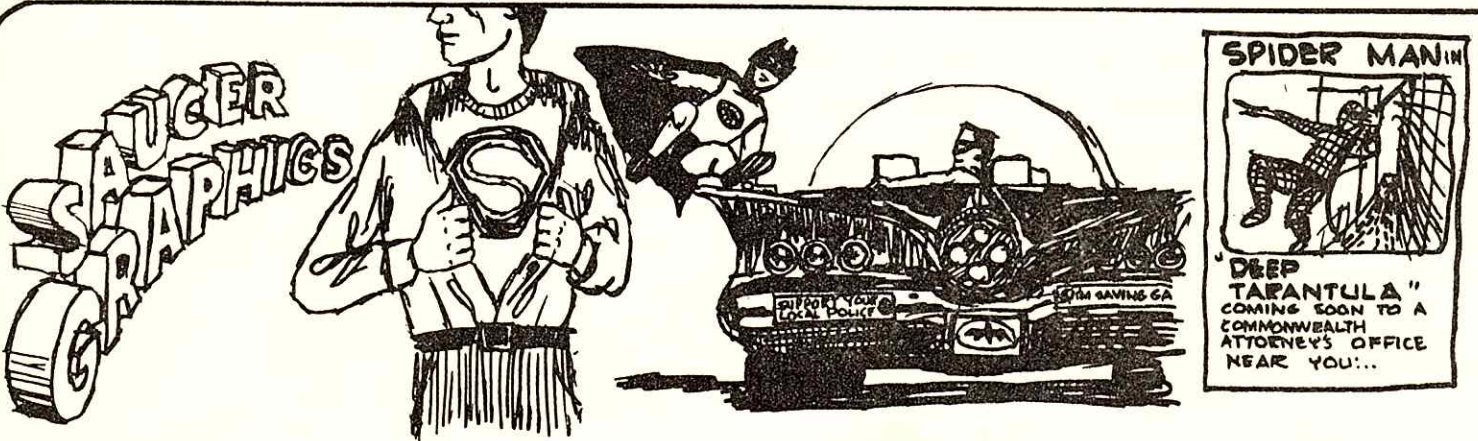
Life Members shall be billed annually for the sum of two dollars (\$2.00). Those Life Members who do not pay the assessment will be removed from the active membership roll and from the mailing list.

The Board proposes another amendment to the By-Laws. Add another paragraph (IV) to Article IV, as follows:

The basic family membership shall consist of one adult individual and either his/her spouse or minor child. Their minor children not included in the basic membership may be included as members of the Club for an annual dues payment of \$5.00 each. After a child attains his/her majority of 18 years, he/she must maintain his/her own individual or family membership if he/she desires to remain a member. Member minor children shall be granted all privileges of membership.

The assessment for Life Members is, in part an effort to help keep the Club in the black. We are at the point where our insurance will begin to cost more than the minimum. The insurance premium starts at \$180 and goes up at \$1 per member over 180. That takes care of one buck; the other is to cover postage on Checkpoints.

It is hoped that the proposed change concerning family membership will eliminate the confusion over who is a family member and who is not.
