



### RALLY REPORT

On October 5, Messrs. Parsley and Wells presented to the waiting world their Silver Anniversary 8-Hour. They have more than a little reason to feel that their exhaustively prepared rally was "snake-bit." The contestants, on the other hand, have no need to blame snakes, sunspots, UFOs, or other mysteries; they know who bit them: Parsley and Wells!

Exhaustive is probably an understatement for the preparation that went into this rally. The course was about 230 miles long, starting near Petersburg, but looping up to Hanover County, then down to Jamestown, across the ferry (!) into Surry, and eventually returning to civilization via 301 and I-95 from somewhere in Sussex. In addition to timing things so that the Jamestown ferry could be part of the course, there was the matter of 17 real controls and at least 3 (that I saw) false controls which had to be set up and staffed. Add to this arrangements for lunch at the Surry House (where contestants breezed through past a line that was 30 people deep) and rooms and banquet at the Red Carpet. Altogether a massive logistical task superbly done.

Then came the snakebites - the DC area's annual BRM bash had its date changed to conflict with ours. After all the planning a paltry 20 cars showed for the event, nearly all from VMSC. Those who didn't show missed some the of most original (if somewhat sneaky) rallying that has been seen in these parts in recent memory.

This brings us to the bites from the two-legged snakes which we poor contestants felt. Things got right off to a typical (for this rally) start - a trap at the beer party the night before the rally! It was done with simple, squeaky-clean, and sneaky style that would become familiar as the event wore on. A line in the generals stated that "Answers to oral questions have no official status;" in other words, it has to be in writing to be official. This led to a gleeful round of evasive (and occasionally misleading) statements given to those who foolishly tried asking verbal questions anyway.

Rally day got off to another grabber; this time in the ODO check! Consider:

21. R or S onto Rt. 630.

does this mean:

21. (R or S) onto Rt. 630.

or does it mean:

21. R or (S onto Rt. 630.)

Well? WHICH?

As it turned out, the first reading was the only one you got a chance to consider, but I for one don't need such uncertainties in the ruddy ODO section!

My butterflies now thoroughly aroused, we ran on, worrying over another grabber, which would later prove to be the cause of the only leg to be thrown for a logic error. The generals said: "An intersection may only be used as the execution point of one SI and one NRI..." (my emphasis), but they also said: "SI's may be executed once, (or) many times...at the first and every opportunity..." Now, does that allow me to execute the same SI at the same intersection, or doesn't it? Don't ask me. The protest committee agreed that it wasn't clear, too. It was typical of the day that we worried about this situation all day long, only to find at the end that it had been used exactly once!

If the general tone of the day was wurra, wurra, wurra, then maybe this next one will show why: are you ready for a trap inside of a transit zone? Several contestants were not! It went like this: after a very small on-course "460" sign, you entered a transit

zone where contestants were parked in the dirt area between two roads. If you spotted the right sign and so got there on the right road, you took the right-hand road out. Otherwise, you took the left, and the next few instructions looped nicely into the control whichever way you went. I'll just bet Len and Lew wish they could have seen the consternation which ensued in that dirt lot as people taking their 15-minute break worried about whether the cars going left or the cars going right were on course!

At the very end of the day, when nobody was ready any more, the snakes who plagued the rally bit the ones who planned it. The biter bit! In the third-from-the-last leg, a monstrous "301" sign which had somehow cleverly eluded detection by all the checkers was detected by something like half the field-resulting in an unhappy finish and the administrative discarding of the last three legs. This was doubly unfortunate because Len and Lew had put together one of the snappiest ending sequences that it has ever been my pleasure to run through. Here's how it went. The last instruction read:

90.39 122) L. CAS 33.6. The last control is .28 mi. from the intersection of Rt. 610 and Rt. 696. This intersection is at OM 90.83. Happy Zeroes!

A little simple arithmetic says that you KNOW that you are going to find the last checkpoint at OM 91.11, which is about one mile after this left, so all you have to do is hop over to 610 and wait for the clock to be right, right? WRONG! Nobody said that the last was the only checkpoint in this mile, and sure enough, just out of sight down the road to the left is the NEXT-to-last checkpoint! Wasn't that fun? But there's more! The slip for the surprise checkpoint says "gain 1.00 min. before OM 91.11." Now, we all know that this control is at OM 90.55, and the last is at 91.11, and the speed is 33.6, so how fast do we have to go when we leave to run the leg and also do the gain? (We even got a five-minute out time to sit and think about it.) Those who took this approach were late. Why? At the stated speed, it takes exactly one minute to traverse the 0.56 miles to the last control. You must gain 1.00 minute. Thus you must ARRIVE at the last control at your OUT time! Yes, Virginia, a 00.00 OET is possible, because I've seen one.

All in all, we worried all day, and had fun anyway. The organizational talent and planning were impressive. The traps were 1) numerous, 2) sneaky, 3) worrisome, 4) squeaky-clean, 5) completely looped. (All of the above.) We thank you, Len and Lew, for a really well done rally.






