

PROTEST RESULTS

CAR #29 protested the the reclassification of his car from c/m to a/m. The protest committee ruled that as this car would not be legal to compete in SCCA Sedan class, it must be classed in a/m as prescribed in section 7.5 of the club speed event regulations.

CAR #53 protested the classification of his car im A/M. As this car has fenders of material other than originally produced, he must be classed in A/M according to the VMSC speed event regulations.

CAR #57 protested the classification of his car in C/M. The protest committee ruled that positive traction rear end is specificly prohibited by section 7.3 because the rear end was not stock on a Vega.

THE BRIDGE OVER TROUBLED WATERS RALLY

Sunday, July 18th, was a beautiful sunny day -- just perfect for a rally. I just wish we had been running one instead of taking a scenic tour of Southside Virginia. Why I was asked to write an article about a rally, which I saw so little of, is beyond me. But far be it from me to question the administrative processes of VMSC.

As I said, Tony and I saw so little of the rally course that most of the information contained in this report is total hearsay -- totally inadmissible in a court of law but quite acceptable for an article in "Checkpoints."

The odo leg was largely uneventful and we didn't get lost. During the first leg we found ourselves roaring down a dirt road and staring at a control -- but wait... there's an intersection just before you reach the checkpoint. Unlike several cars in the event, we didn't fall for this trap, we turned left and invented our own. As we were driving on a road the Virginia Department of Highways had seen fit to repair, we spotted a "weight limit." As I was writing it down to make sure we executed the special, Tony said, "One lane bridge" -- I looked up and thought, "Yep, that sure is a one lane bridge -- wonder why they didn't put up a sign." Nothing more was said about it -- Tony thinking that I'd seen the sign, me thinking that Tony hadn't read the generals -- and we were blithely on our way to North Carolina. We finally decided we were lost and backtracked to the first control we saw -- only to find out it was the second control.

On the third leg we had to gain three minutes in three miles which was simple enough as long as your driver was watching the odometer -- which he wasn't -- so that you didn't execute an instruction in the three mile free zone -- which we did. And we came through the control backwards.

The fourth leg, as near as I could gather had a non-backward facing backward facing sign somewhere on it. We missed it and came through backwards -- again.

The fifth leg, before lunch, was sort of an innocuous little confidence leg -- and it was about time, I might add -- on which we took a 27 or 28. But with 1600 points, we had sort of stopped counting by then.

The sixth and seventh sections have faded in my memory since the rally. We didn't get lost but we didn't score very well either -- two of our better legs.

The eighth leg was the one when it seemed like we were trying to execute twelve different specials at each intersection due to that wonderful overlap paragraph. After we had muddled through everything, we came to instruction #48 -- "Mt. Hope Baptist Church Cancel SI 1 and SI 5." I said to Tony that it didn't contain NRC so we had to change our route there. He said, "Are you sure?" I told him, of course, I was sure. But by this time the only thing I was really sure of was that we were still in the continental United States.



But it was really more like misery loves company when we'd found we'd all paused and piddled ourselves into a max.

The control slip at the ninth control wished us all good luck on the unmanned leg. But that was more like a sucker punch than official information, because there was yet another manned control before you began the unmanned leg. Several cars used lettered instruction D to cancel special instruction #4, but a letter instruction couldn't cancel a special so it was still in effect. We executed this section properly and with our swelled heads and inflated egos, began counting intersection of Rt. 360 without once realizing that you had to complete the unmanned leg before you could begin to worry about the .50 pause at each intersection -- which was, by then, irrelevant.

To put it all into perspective, I'd have to say I'm much wiser for the experience. The next time Peter and Libby put on a rally, I'm going to work it.


