

RALLYE REPORT

The 1977 VMSC motor sport season commenced under circumstances that were clearly outside the norm. This event was unique in two respects. everyone started the rally with same number of points --Secondly, it produced the most unusual ODO leg in recent history with a tour of a yet to be renovated section of Richmond and the first trap of the year.


VMSC GROWS ITS OWN
