

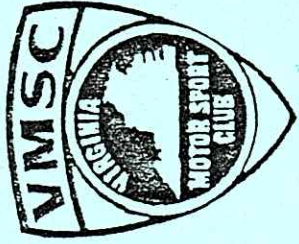

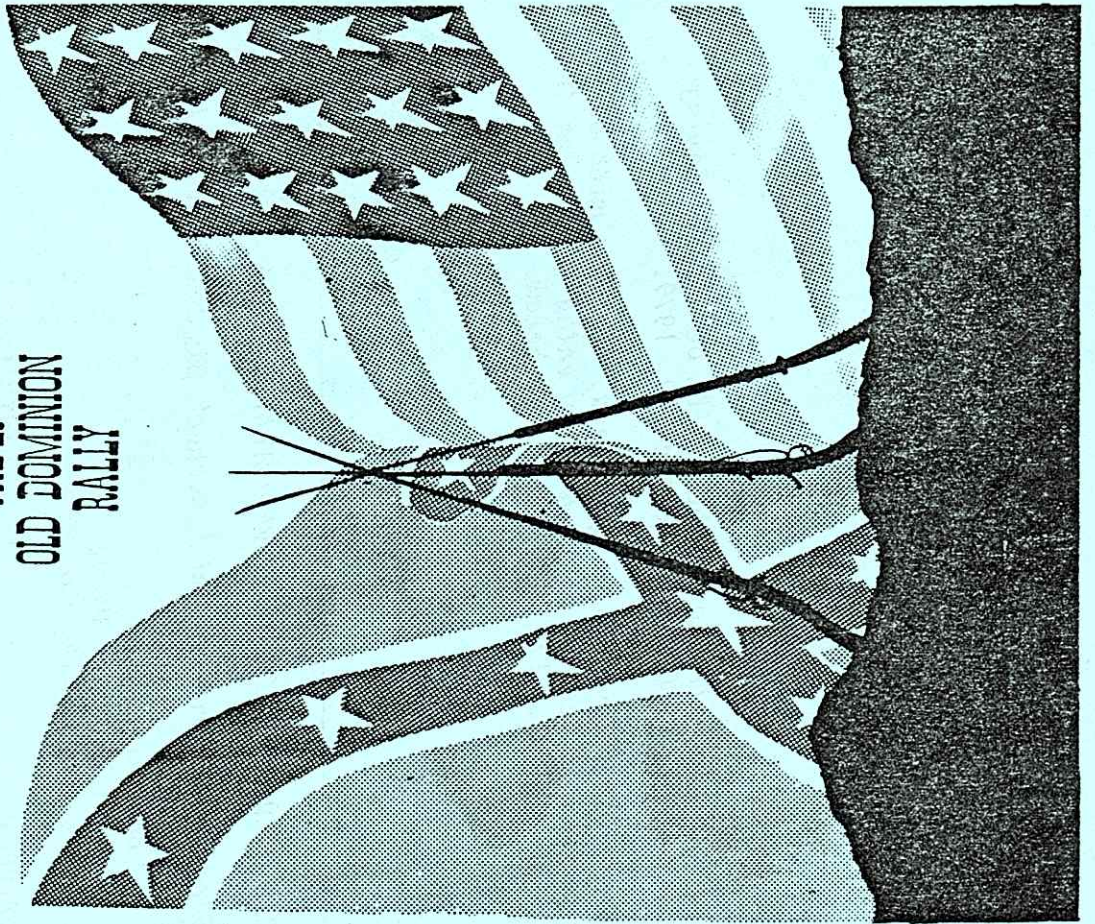

### CONCEPT

The 21st running of the Old Dominion Rally is presented by the Virginia Motor Sport Club. It is a low-pressure event with beautiful scenery and excellent rally roads, low difficulty course-following; an event all levels of experience will be challenged by and enjoy. The event will run the weekend of November 10 and 11, 1979; it is 285 miles in total length, with 11% dirt.

### COST

\$25 per team. Includes cocktail parties Saturday and Sunday, and the awards presentation banquet Sunday at the Executive Motor Inn in Richmond.

### START

Richmond, Virginia at the Willow Lawn Shopping Center at the corner of Broad Street and Willow Lawn Drive, ½ mile west of Broad's intersection with Staples Mill Road. Registration opens at 8:00 AM to 9:15; FCO at 9:31 AM, Saturday, November 10.

### LODGING

Overnight accommodations Saturday will be at the Ramada Inn, Fredericksburg, Virginia, on Rt. 3 just west of I-95. Management at Ramada will give a 20% discount to participants for rooms. There will be no formal registration on Sunday, with FCO from the Ramada at 9:01 AM, November 11.

### TROPHIES

Trophies for the 21st Old Dominion will be individually crafted and personalized on Sunday following the event. There will be 3 classes in which to compete: equipped, unequipped and Rookie (explained in the generals). Marque awards and doorprizes will be given as donated (there are now awards for Best Datsun/Saab, Porsche/Audi/Fiat, British Car, and BMW/Mercedes/Toyota).

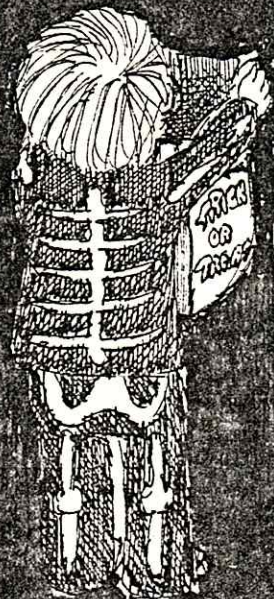

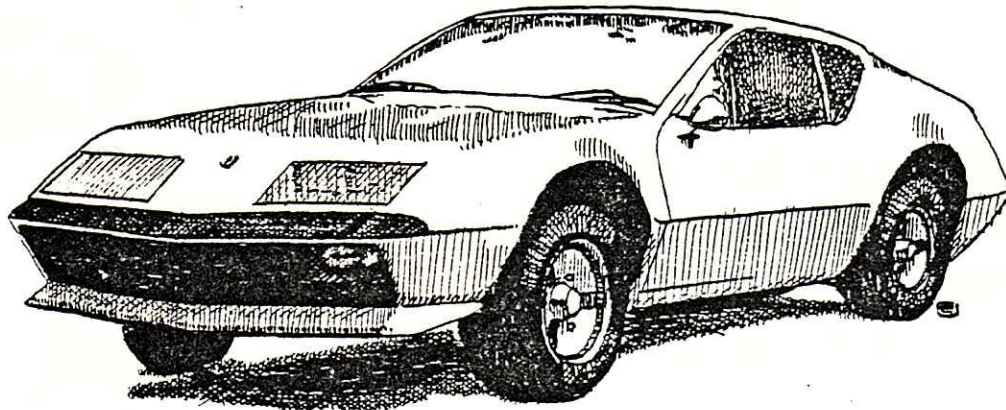

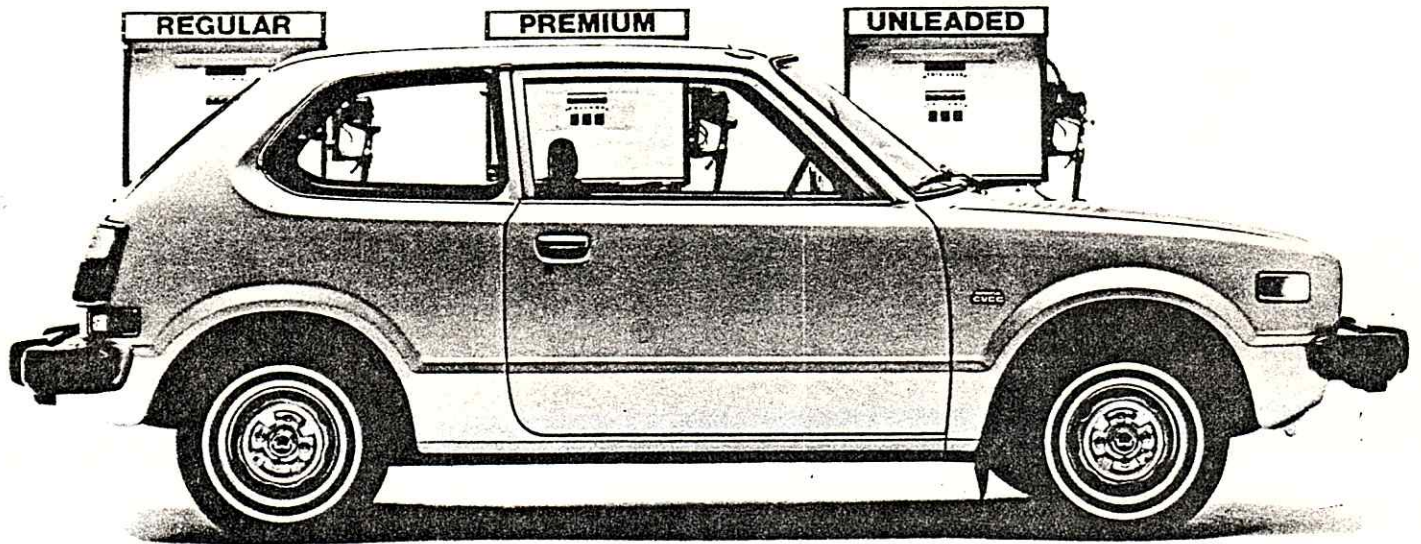
