A LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

TO THE MEMBERS:

Generally my contributions to Checkpoints have always been of the jocular nature. There is however a serious side to VMSC-- topics and items that must be brought forth and discussed. These include rally protests and autocross classing complaints ad infinitum (perhaps, ad nauseum, too) but they are of the temporary nature. The chief concern that the club faces each year is a common one-- money.

With this in mind, VMSC will attempt to create a budget for 1982. The intent of this budget is not to cut expenses so much as to determine exactly what and where our expenditures are and then generate enough income to cover them. The budget that will be proposed will chiefly set guidelines for disbursements.

It is my opinion that massive cutting of expenses (cheaper flyers, cheaper and fewer trophies, etc.) would actually hurt VMSC in the long run because the people who participate in our events would feel cheated. We should instead look into means of increasing our revenues. At present there is a suggestion to increase our entry fees to seven dollars per event. Since the club hasn't raised the price of admission, so to speak, in three years, this proposal seems a reasonable one.

In addition, Bookie Westbrook has agreed to take on the position of VMSC Advertising Manager. In the past, we have solicited money from our sponsors in a rather piecemeal manner: Checkpoints advertising, car show sponsorship, Old Dominion Rally sponsorship. It's surprising that these people don't get tired of seeing us asking for money three times a year. The idea this year will be to offer a package in which the sponsor will get an ad in Checkpoints and advertising by way of the car show and the Old Dominion Rally. It will involve a one-time only charge and should help our relations with our sponsors and benefit them, through the advertising, at the same time.

There is another source of revenue that has decreased dramatically in the last few years--autocrosses. It would appear that the quality and availability of lots at our disposal has been a prime factor in the decrease in attendance. To help alleviate this situation, I have placed Shelia Hunter in charge of a committee to locate new autocross sites. Committee members are John Adams, Floyd Mills, and Barbara Stout. This group will serve as a clearing house for information and help eliminate the duplication of effort that often occurs. If members don't have the time and/or inclination to contact the powers that be about the availability of certain locations, they should give any pertinent information to the committee so that the club can promptly determine whether or not the site can be used.

I wish the club luck in 1982, hopefully we won't need it.

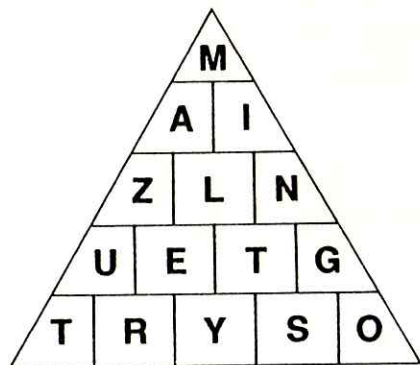

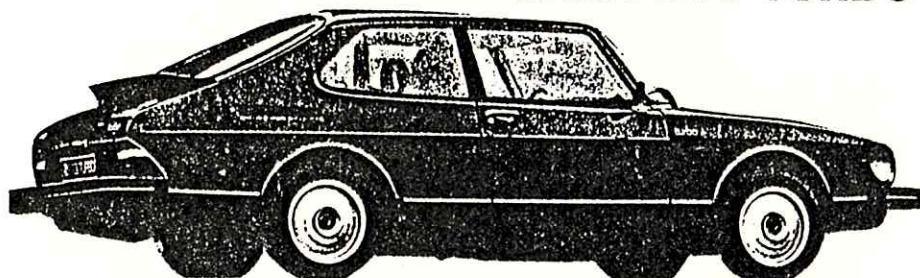
SOLUTION TO THE DECEMBER PUZZLE

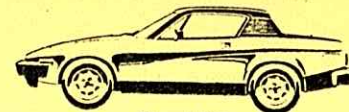
