




Just-when-you-thought-it-was-safe...., from the book, play, movie & sand bucket of a similar name.



The bus stopped for a traffic light. The biker couldn't see the light - All he could see was yellow bus back, from 10 feet and closing.


I guess sol - I had to turn right to come back to Richmond.


