





Elsewhere in this issue you will find changes to the autocross competition regulations as submitted to the Board by the A/X competition committee. If adopted, these changes will be retroactive to the beginning of the 1984 competitive season.

These changes are probably as close to brilliance as the comp committee will ever come. They have apparently solved the problems of unfair homologation that dogged the old system without totally abandoning the homologation format. The capable driver will not suffer a points penalty simply because he/she runs in a sparse class, while the homologation snowball will not be allowed to lump radically dissimilar cars in the same points class.

Your editors enthusiastically support these changes, but you should vote for them anyway.

Sarah came to our staff on July 12, 1984, at 3:12 PM and weighed in at 61b, 12oz. Once settled, Sarah will report on various club activities.



#### Competition Regulations

Page 12, Section 4.1.D: Delete entire section and substitute new section:

These awards will be based on Points for finishing position in each class or homologated class within that category. They shall be awarded as in Regulation 4.1.A. In addition, the first place driver with the highest accumulation of Speed Points for the year, will have the Overall Championship noted on the 1st place category award.

Event trophies shall be awarded based on one (1) trophy for each five (5) entries or fraction thereof in each class.




