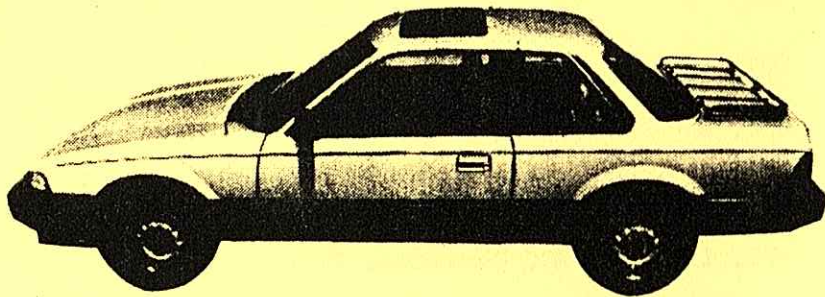

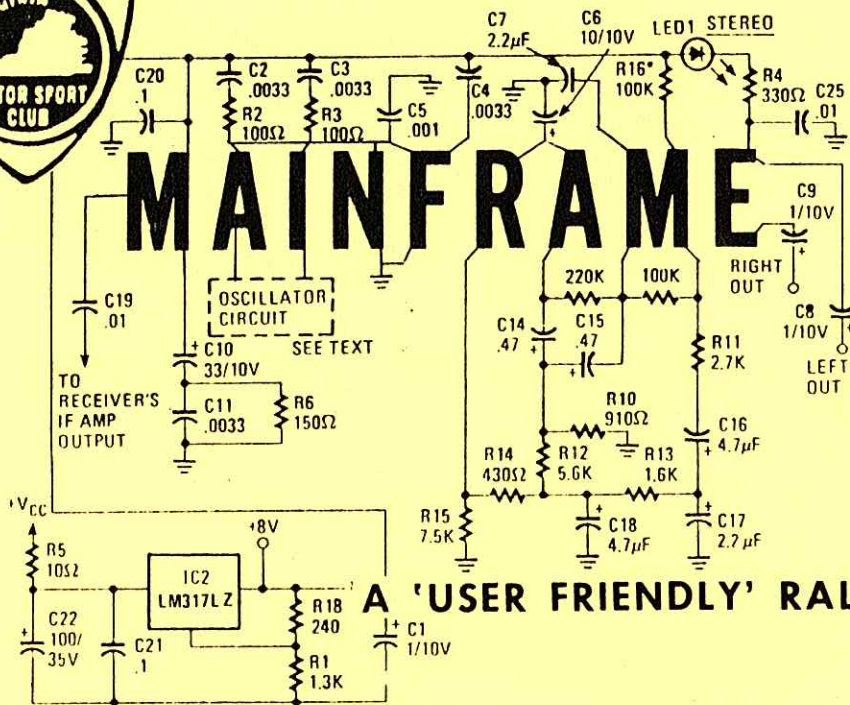

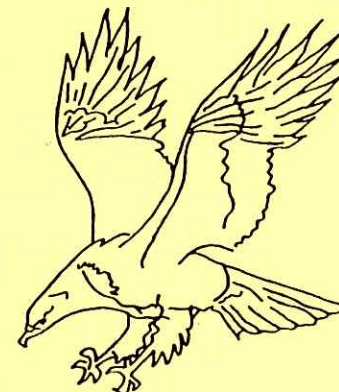

As far as I'm concerned, there are only two valid reasons for driving your car in New York City; the first is to get you out of town--and so is the second.

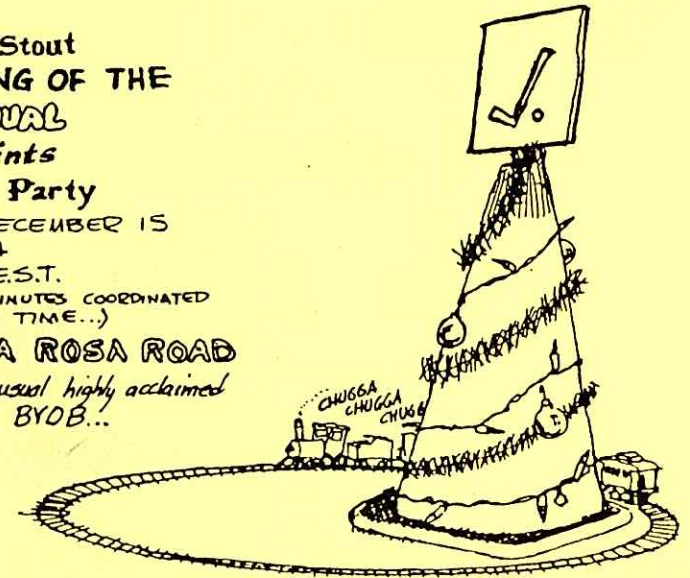

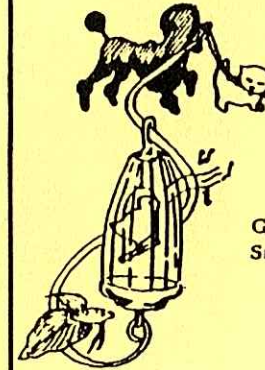
