

"MAY RALLY" (may not)



The exellent organization and event administration that has become a hallmark of "SERIES 3" will continue. Registration will be restricted to 150 cars. Pre-registration prior to JUNE 1st. guarantees you an opportunity to compete and reserves the same car number for all three events. The registration fee for all three events is \$23.00 or \$9.00 for each individual event. Dash plaques will be given to the first 100 entrants.

The event will be run \underline{RAIN} or \underline{SHINE} . Registration and tech inspection will open at 8:00 AM, first car off at 9:00 AM. Registration will remain open until 3:00 PM.




