Registration will be limited to 80 cars. Pre-registration prior to September 9th is strongly recommended. Entry fee for registration by September 9th will be \$22.00 per car for the event, after the 9th, \$25.00. The event fee includes Saturday's practice and timed runs, Barbeque Dinner, the event keg party, and Sunday's timed runs. Lodging is available at the Weston's Motel ((804) 645-7761) (Autocross Headquarters) in Crewe (see map), and at the Wedgewood Motor Inn ((804) 292-7288) on Route 40 in Blackstone. Contestants will be responsible for making their own reservations.

Ladies Auxiliary of Crewe Fire Dept. will serve a Home Cooked Barbeque Dinner at 6:30 PM Saturday Evening. The cost is included in the entry fee, extra meal tickets are \$ 6.00 per person, children under 12 years old \$ 3.00. The meal will be barbeque, cole slaw, potato salad, sliced tomatoes, iced tea, and dessert. This is the best buy in the area and will support a good cause; also, it is tax deductible. Include the amount for your extra meal tickets with your entry fee (we must advise them of the number of meals required).

The Ladies Auxiliary of the Crewe Fire Department will be at the hanger on Saturday and Sunday with coffee, pastries, sandwiches and drinks available for purchase. Please support their efforts.

Blackstone Championship Autocross IV will be a simple fast course with no walk-throughs or drive throughs. This will be the same 2 mile course as last years', conditions permitting. Car numbers will be assigned by a drawing on September 11th (there will be allowances for multiple driver cars). It will run using MWCSCC Classes as amended by VMSC. Exhaust suppression required for all stock and prepared cars, rollover protection required for all open top cars, and 1 3/4" minimum ground clearance required. Scoring will be based on the Best Time out of two runs on Saturday added to the Best Time out of three runs on Sunday.

For VMSC members this event will count as two events for Points, and one event for Trophies.

An initiation fee of \$25.00 will be charged to all new members.

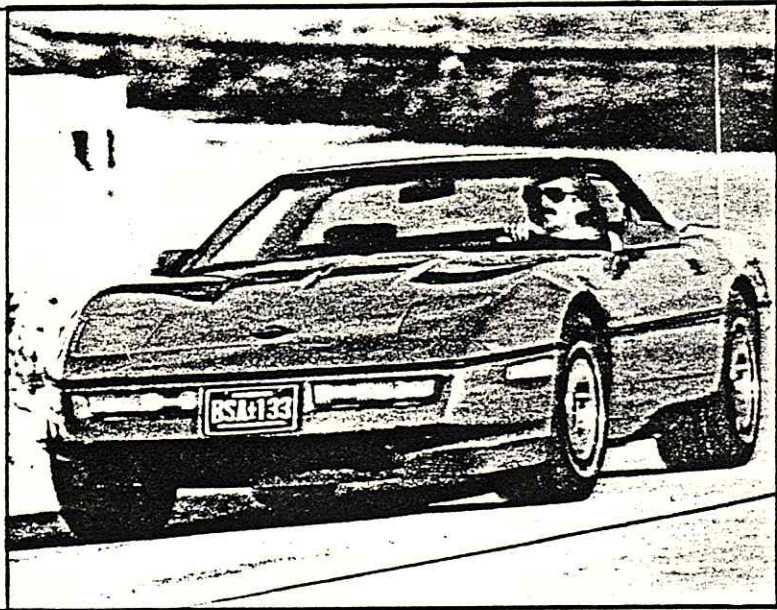
For members in arrears past February 1 or 60 days after billing date, whichever is later, a \$10.00 re-initiation fee will be charged.

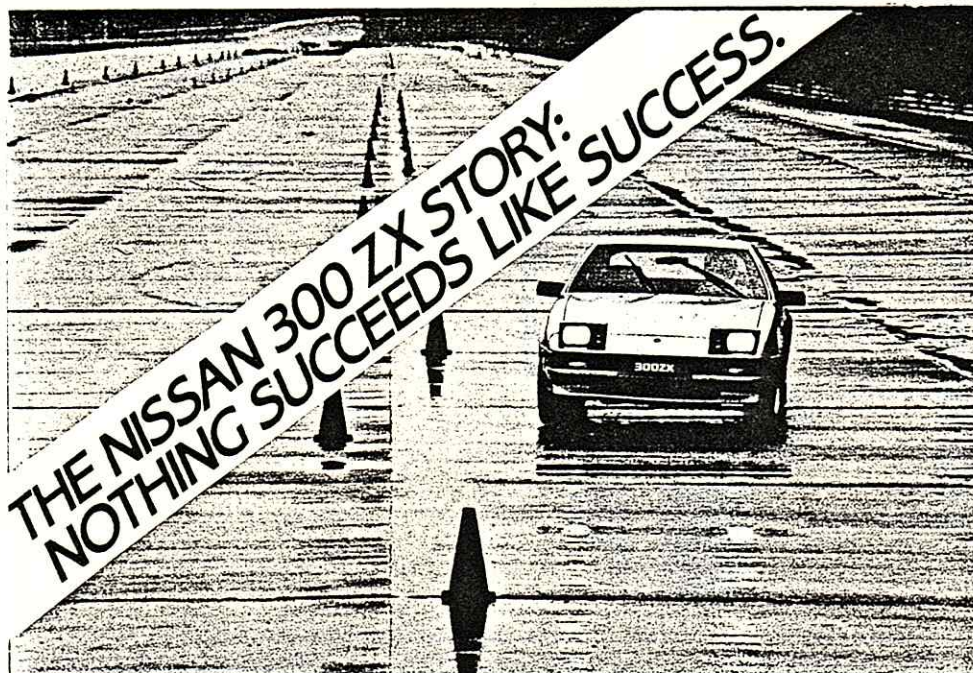

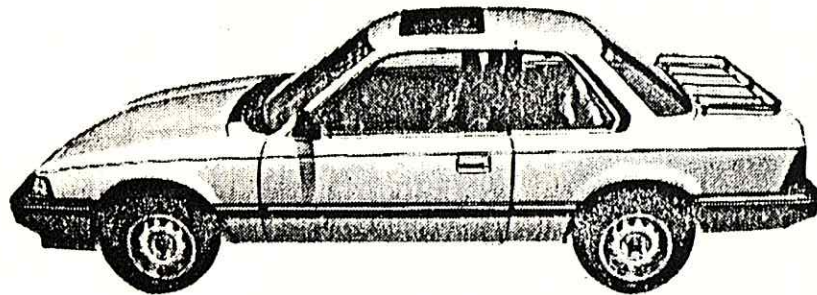
