- Favorite song - a bit of a surprise here, we expected "Short People" to be the runaway winner but it was beaten by "Like a Virgin" (draw your own conclusions)

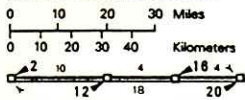

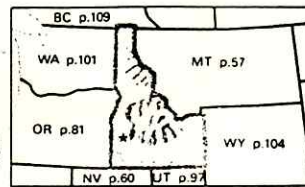
How to Determine Distance



Mileage in red between red arrowheads, in black between intersections. Some interchange numbers indicate mileage.

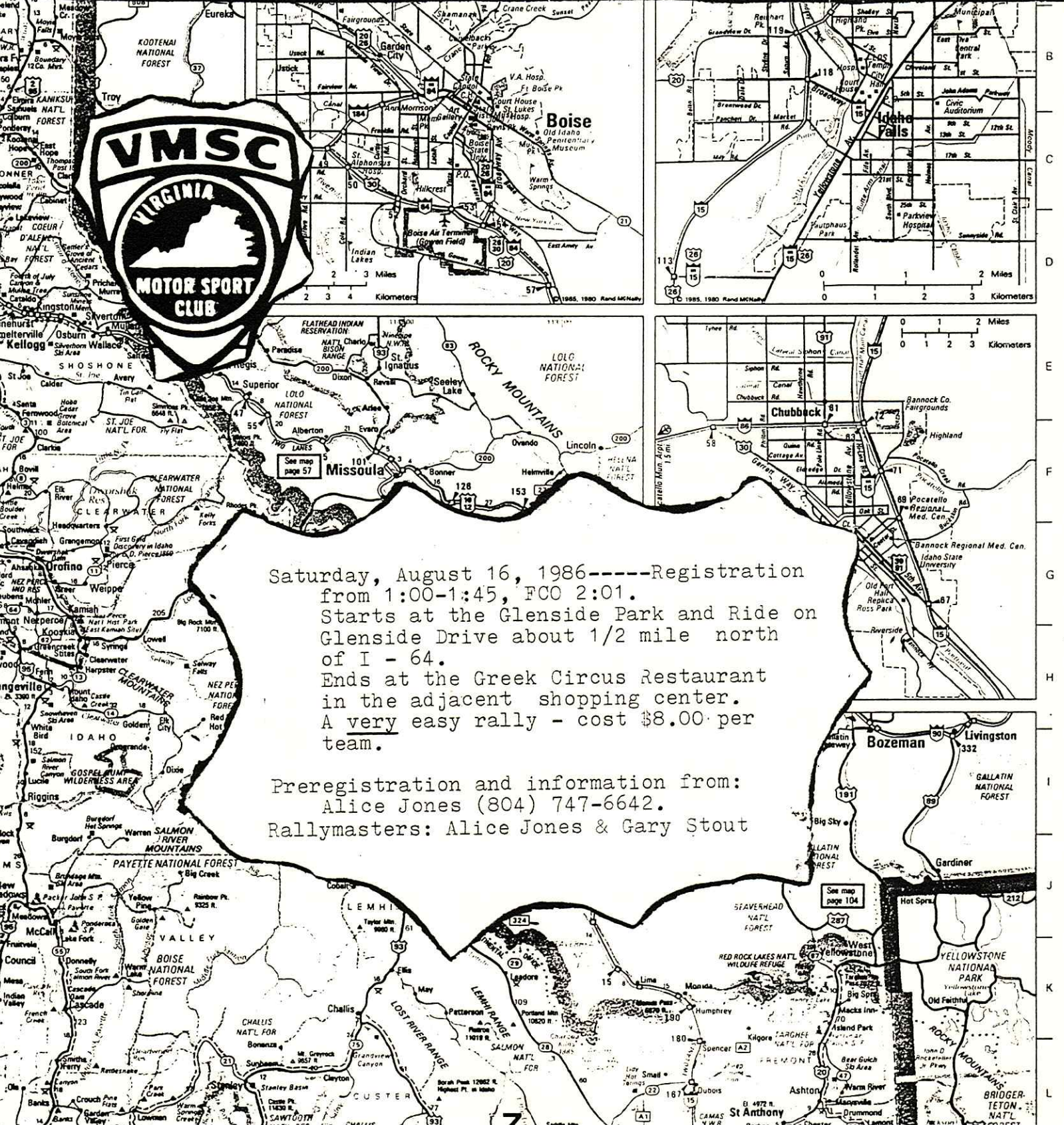

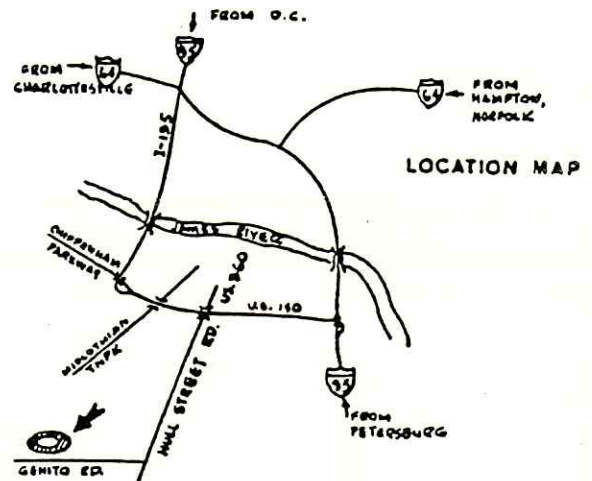

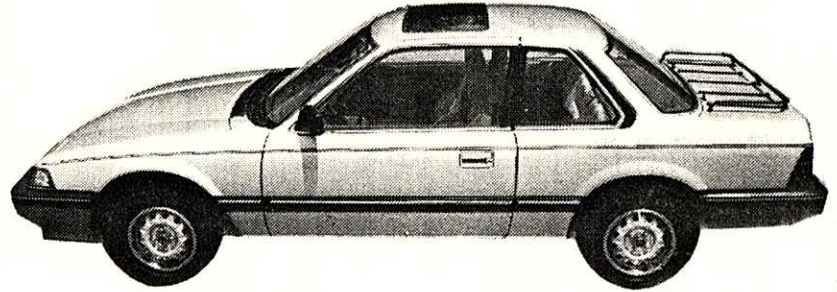
