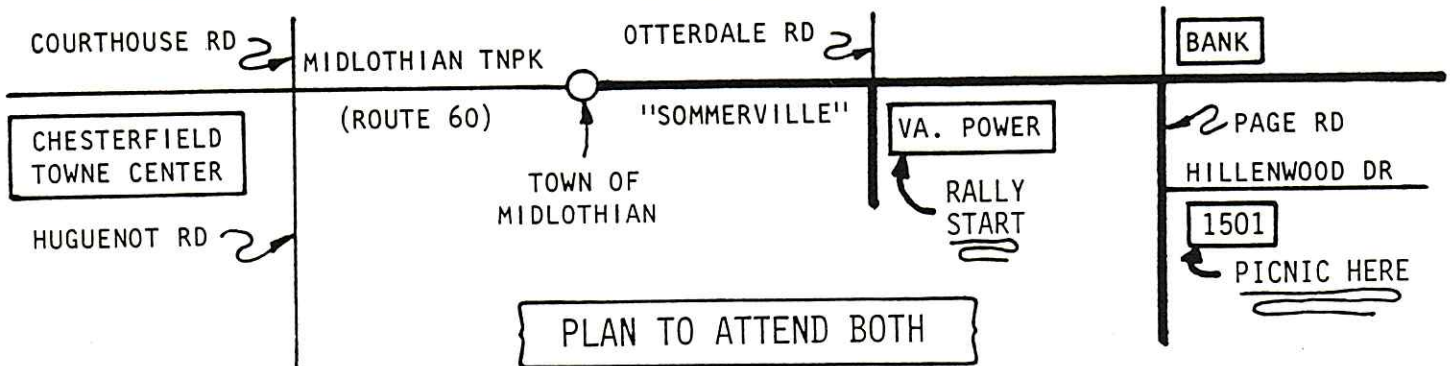
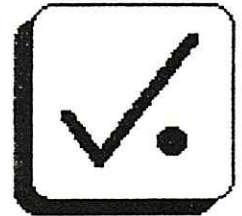
This fun filled event ends at the picnic, however it is not mandatory that you attend the picnic in order to compete in the rally.
