1. **Eligibility**
Any driver competing in the Virginia State Autocross Championship Series is eligible for the 1992 Car Guys™/VSAC Series Contingency Plan.

2. **Requirements**
To qualify for the program, eligible drivers must register in advance with Car Guys™. Forms are available by writing to Car Guys™ at P.O. Box 21275, Roanoke, VA 24018 or by calling (703) 772-1517 during business hours. Drivers also must display a Car Guys™ logo in plain sight on their competition vehicles. Logos will be made available at no charge to pre-registered, eligible drivers.

3. **Awarding of Credit**
An eligible driver who meets the above requirements and who wins an overall class championship in the 1992 Virginia State Autocross Championship (VSAC) Series will receive a \$50 credit toward a 1993 Car Guys™ school. Credit certificates will be issued by Car Guys™ upon receipt of the official results from the VSAC Series chairman.

4. **Classes**
Three cars will constitute a valid class. The winner of a class with fewer than three cars will receive \$25 credit as long as all other criteria are met.

5. **Restrictions**
Credits may be applied only to the full price (as stated on the event application) of a Car Guys™ school and may not be applied in conjunction with any club discount or promotion. Credits are not transferable from one driver to another. Credits cannot be redeemed for cash.

6. **Time Limits**
Credits must be applied to an event by the end of the 1993 Car Guys™ schedule.

7. **Jurisdiction**
All entrants are subject to VSAC rules and regulations. Car Guys™ will consider the decisions of the individual event chairmen to be final.

1992 VIRGINIA STATE AUTOCROSS CHAMPIONSHIP
Supplementary Rules & Regulations

I. PURPOSE
To challenge all racers to compete for the title of Virginia State Autocross Class Champion.

II. EVENTS
Four clubs will designate one of their regular events as a Championship points event. Best three of the four events will be used to establish the champion for the class. Participants must run two of the four events to be eligible for a title.

III. SAFETY AND ADMINISTRATION
Each participating club will run their event under their regular competition and administration rules except as modified herein. Each club will nominate one member to serve as the competition board to determine series awards, planning, scheduling and administration duties. These personnel are as follows, as of 6/8/92: Series Co-ordinator- Tom Stangler (SCCA # 63 R157902)
VNSC- Dick Boogher, TSCC- Dave Cutchins, ODRSCCA- Dale Blankenship, BRSSCA- Greg Hastings

IV. CLASSES
Classing for the Championship shall be in accordance with the 1992 Sports Car Club of America Solo 11@ rules. This will not prevent each club from running their own classes for calculating their standings for their event. This applies to the series classes only. Each club shall provide a set of results in the classing format designated for the series. (No novice class/combined ladies class). An entrant may compete in one class only for series awards.

V. BUMPING
There will be no bumping (in the series results) for class points or trophies. Each club may bump for their own event according to their normal procedure but competitors shall receive points in their original class for the series standings.

VI. AWARDS
Each club will be responsible for individual event awards as they see fit and according with their normal procedure. Series awards will be given as follows:

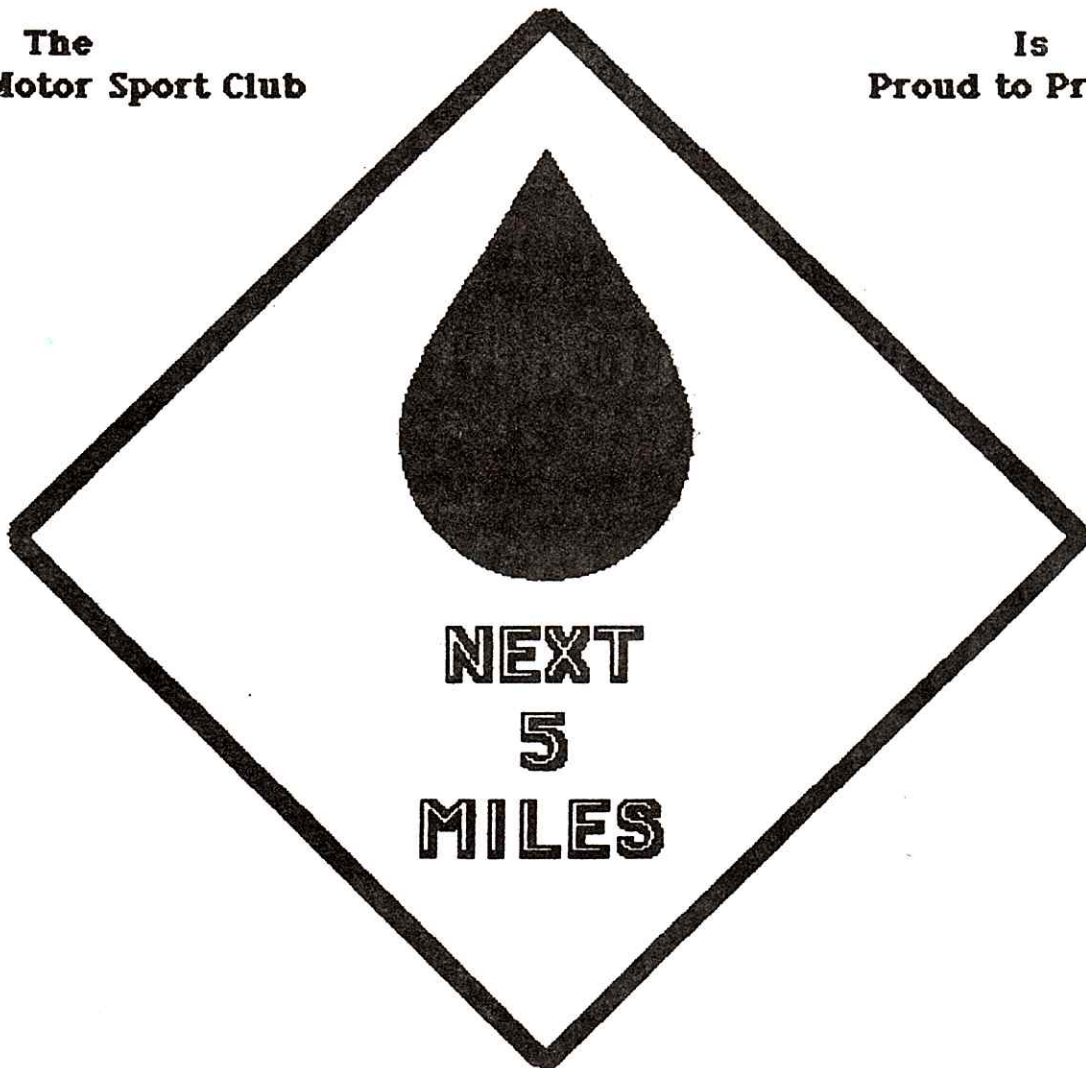
1. Class Champions will receive VSAC 1992 Class Champion stickers for their cars and a personalized certificate, and an award from The Car Guys Inc.
2. Competitors finishing second and third will also receive certificates according to the number of competitors; four or more for second place awards, six or more for third place awards.
3. Other awards will be as finances allow.

VII. POINTS
Series points shall be awarded in the following manner: 9, 7, 5, 3, 2, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1. In addition, each competitor shall receive 2 points for each competitor in their class that they finish ahead of at each race.

VIII. ENTRY FEES
Each club shall forward two dollars per entrant who attended their designated championship event to go toward series awards. This money shall be forwarded to the series co-ordinator along with the results of the event. Each club shall set their entry fee for their event.
