A significant number of date changes have occurred in this year's Rally Schedule. Specifically:

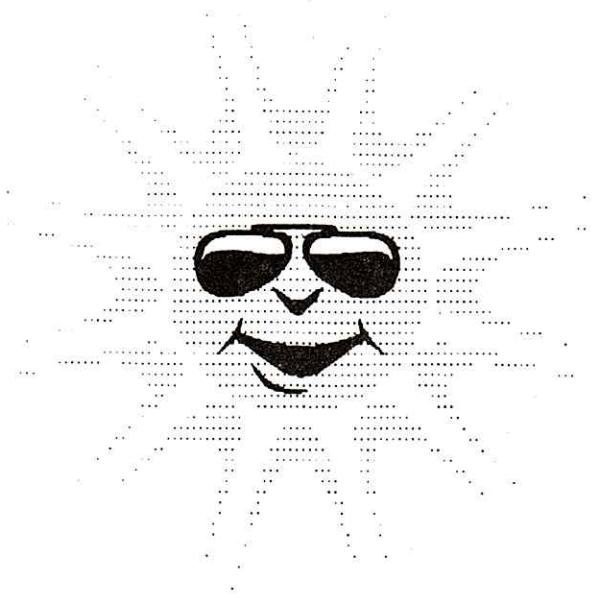

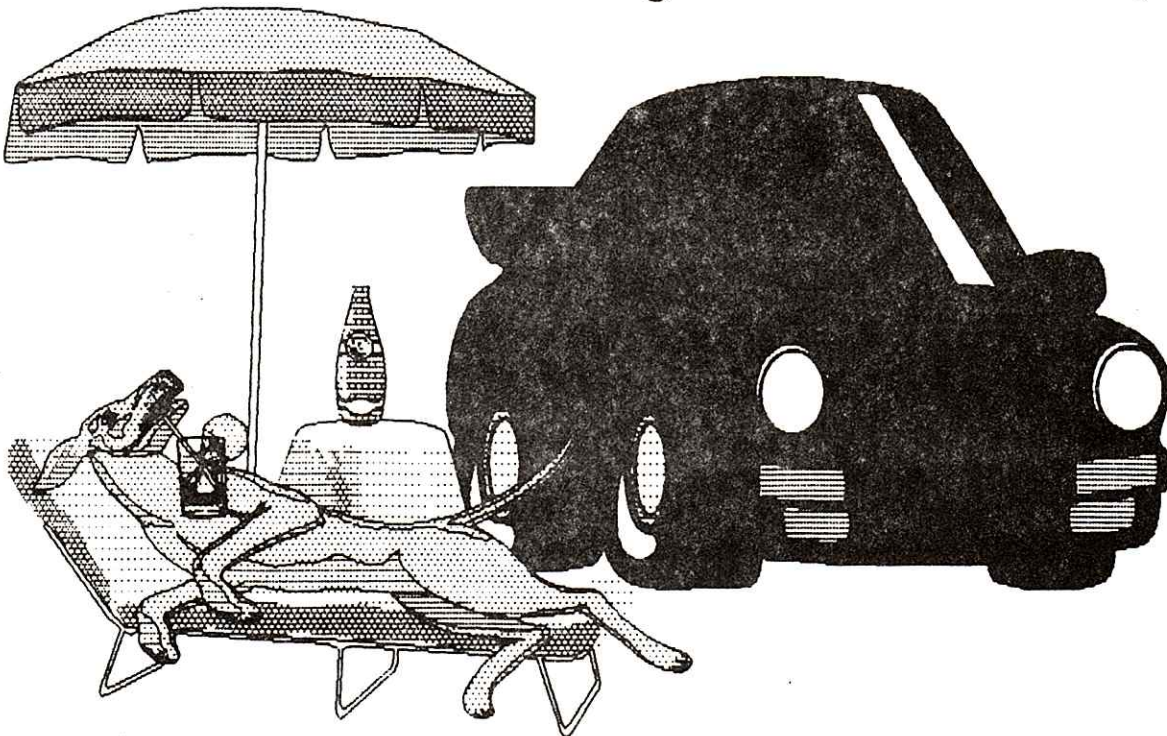
