

BEFORE PRO SOLO AND NATIONAL TOURS THERE WAS SERIES 3. 1994 IS THE 19TH ANNIVERSARY OF VMSC'S PREMIER EVENT, THE ORIGINAL SERIES 3 ROADCROSS. JUST THE NAME BRINGS BACK MEMORIES.

I BEGAN AUTOCROSSING IN THE FALL OF 1976 AND RAN MY FIRST SERIES 3 IN 1977. THE FOLLOWING YEAR, 1978, MARKED THE END OF THE ORIGINAL COURSE DUE TO CHANGES AT THE STATE FAIRGROUNDS. I DON'T THINK ANYONE WHO RAN THE ORIGINAL COURSE WILL FORGET IT. I EVEN FELT GUILTY IN THE FALL 1992 BY NAMING OUR WINTER SERIES, 'SERIES 3 WINTERCROSS'.

WHAT IS A ROADCROSS? ISN'T IT JUST ANOTHER NAME FOR AN AUTOCROSS? THOUGH I'VE NEVER SEEN A WRITTEN DEFINITION OF THE WORD, I CAN SAY FOR ME, THE ANSWER IS A DEFINITE NO!

WHAT BEST DESCRIBES "ROADCROSS" IS A COMBINATION OF ROAD COURSE AND AUTOCROSS. ROAD COURSES SELDOM, IF EVER CHANGE AND ARE HIGH SPEED EVENTS THAT FOLLOW THE PAVEMENT. WHAT YOU LEARN BY RUNNING A ROADCOURSE AND A ROADCROSS ONCE, TWICE OR THREE TIMES CARRIES OVER DIRECTLY TO RUNNING IT AGAIN. AN AUTOCROSS IS A LOW SPEED EVENT ON A COURSE THAT IS SELDOM, IF EVER REPEATED AS IT IS MEANT TO SHOW YOUR SKILL AT QUICKLY ADAPTING TO A NEW COURSE. A ROADCROSS, THUS IS A LOW SPEED COURSE, THE FASTEST CAR SHOULD NOT EXCEED 70 MPH, THAT FOLLOWS THE PAVEMENT AND IS REPEATED, ALLOWING YOU TO DIRECTLY COMPARE YOUR PERFORMANCE OVER TIME OR WITH DIFFERENT CARS TO YOURSELF AND OTHERS.

THIS YEARS COURSE, BASED ON A HIGHLY ACCLAIMED NOV. 93 COURSE IS THE 4TH DESIGN FOR THE SERIES AND THE THIRD AT SOUTHSIDE SPEEDWAY. THE FIRST SOUTHSIDE DESIGN WAS FORCED TO RUN ENTIRELY ON THE TRACK AS THERE WAS NO INFIELD PAVING. THE SECOND SOUTHSIDE DESIGN TOOK ADVANTAGE OF THE THEN NEW PAVED PIT ENTRY AND EXIT ROADS THAT ALLOWED A FIGURE 8 OF SORTS. THIS MADE FOR SOME EXCITING INFIELD ENTRIES AND EXITS, BUT ALSO CAUSED SOME HARSH ACUTE UP AND DOWN HILL ENTRIES AND EXITS. THE 1994 COURSE, THIRD SOUTHSIDE DESIGN, UTILIZES SOME OF THE EVEN NEWER PAVED INFIELD AND ALL THREE PIT ENTRY/EXIT ROADS TO ACHIEVE A COURSE THAT IS VERY FLOWING WITH NO HARSH OR ACUTE UP OR DOWN HILL TURNS AND EVEN GIVES EQUAL LEFT RIGHT TIRE WEAR!

NOW THERE ARE PRO SOLO'S AND NATIONAL TOURS AND SERIES 3 DEMANDS THE BEST VMSC HAS TO OFFER AND I WILL DO WHAT I CAN TO SEE THAT EVERYONE GETS IT.




